Known across the globe as the King of Action Painting, Prof. Dr. Theodorus Michael Berthus Sijrier, THEOS, was born on the 27th of December, 1947 in Rotterdam, Netherlands.

THEOS – The King of Action Painting

Prof. Dr. Theos was a great artist and was known as the “King of Action Painting”, a title which Pablo Picasso gave him when he met the young, talented and ambitious THEOS in one of their first joint exhibitions.

When very young, Prof. Dr. Theos found Jackson Pollock’s artistic style particularly impressive, which made a strong impression on him. It was perhaps this encounter which led Prof. Dr. Theos to train in arts and painting with a focus on Abstract Expressionism.

He also collaborated with many greats of action painting and Abstract Expressionism like Willem de Kooning, John Cordell, Anatol et al to create masterpieces which have found a lot of international recognition and admiration.

He attended one of the prestigious art schools in the Netherlands known as the Academy for the Art (later named after an alumnus and famous artist, Willem de Kooning) from 1963 to 1967. He also studied at the Royal Academy of Fine Arts, Antwerp in Belgium between 1967 and 1971; and the Art Academy Dusseldorf, Germany in 1974 and 1975, with Joseph Beuys and Anatol.

He also started parttime studies in psychology the following year. THEOS met the great action painter Willem de Kooning in 1971 and was struck with his admiration. It was the beginning of his journey into the world of abstract art which featured mainly in gestural paintings, gestural abstraction and abstract impressionism. This association and admiration helped THEOS develop a strong artistic appetite for Action Painting.

It was in the year 1975 when he registered and started as a free artist, the brand name THEOS was born.

As he started getting more and more creative, he participated in individual and group exhibitions around the world with his unique artworks.

His individual and group exhibitions have been held in Brussels, Antwerp (Belgium), Paris (France), Düsseldorf, Berlin (Germany), Ibiza (Spain), London (England), Malmö (Sweden), Heeswijk, Den Haag, Eindhoven, Rotterdam (Netherlands), Los Angeles, New York (USA) and Barcelona (Spain).

New York Awarded a lifelong visiting professorship at the Columbia University, New York City.

Riga Visiting professorship, Action Painting, at the Art Academy of Latvia.

2021

Bangui Appointment as Professor Vice Rector and Dean of the Faculty of Arts at ATAFOM University International, Central African Republic.

Paintings by the Late Prof. Dr. THEOS are in the collections of the Museum of Modern Art (San Francisco), the Winckelmann Museum (Stendal, Germany), The Clemens-Sell Museum (Neuss, Germany), The Royal Family of the Netherlands, The SayArtsCollection (Türkiye) and many other private collectors.

Similarly, he has been involved in a lot of performances that promoted the philosophy of Action Painting all around the world and collaboration with many great impressionists and artists such as Pablo Picasso in London, David Hockney in London, Corneille in Eindhoven, Anton Heyboer in Eindhoven, Karel Appel in Rotterdam, Wasseburg Hanshaus in Rotterdam, Willem de Kooning in Zuidwolde, Clive Miller in Zuidwolde and many more.

Some of his works are displayed in the ATAFOM Digital Museum and on several other online platforms and museums in the world. Some of his great designs remain untitled, however, other titles include; "Without You" (2007), "Summertime" (2008), "Back to Germany" (2009), "Garden Around the House" (2011).

The co-operation partner for the Department of Fine Arts of ATAFOM University, SayArtsCollection owns the exclusive rights to marketing and selling THEOS works since 2008.

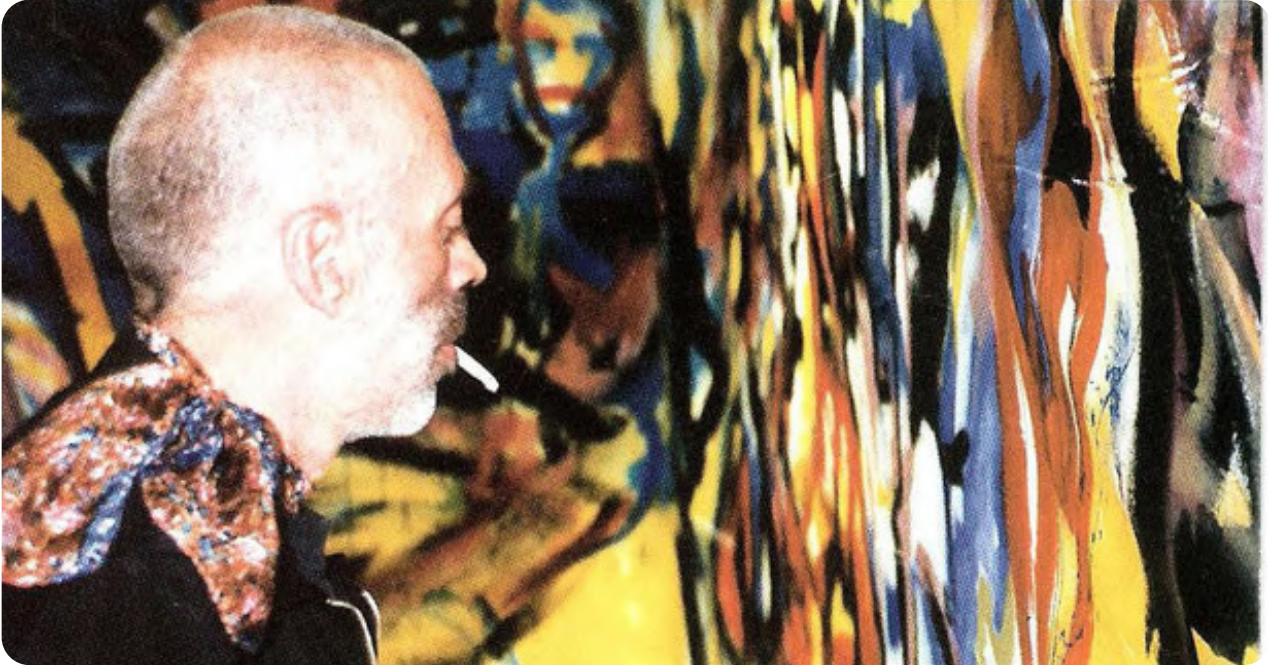

A tall, slim man of international renown, slender with sensual lips and fiery eyes and yet with a transparent, glassy and fragile personality, THEOS was loved for his eccentric – elegant charisma, his charm, humour and spirit. And in turn, he loved women – seven times married, six times divorced, once widowed, several children and yet the search for the perfect muse seemed never ending.



Life well Lived

For years he lived an excessive, restless life in the fast lane. Women, alcohol and drugs were just as much a part of it as his art. He narrowly escaped the social collapse in which many of his prominent contemporaries, such as Immendorf, Friedmann, Konstantin Wecker fell.



His Battles

It was his battle with severe lung cancer which got him out of this vicious circle in 1997. From 1998 he began visiting a Hindu monastery in Bali for meditation. There, he regularly visited a shaman who helped activate his body's defences.

All this while THEOS continued his battle with Lung Cancer and in December 2007 it took a turn for the worse. At his request, his friend Mr. Yavuz then sent him back to Bali in 2010 to conquer his illness there.

In Bali, THEOS regained new courage to face life, new energy and he created excellent new masterpieces that reflect his freshly gained vitality in a great way.

THEOS not only conquered his illness, but also conquered his addiction to drugs and alcohol.

THEOS married for the eighth time; converted to Islam and lived very happily in Bali with his wife and son. This relaxed environment brimming with artistic freedom helped him create his new masterpieces.

The love for teaching and charity brought THEOS and Mr. Yavuz closer together and the current collaboration for the Department of Fine Arts in the Faculty of Arts at the ATAFOM University was forged.

The training and curriculum of the programme at ATAFOM University are geared towards achieving the ideals of Prof. Dr. THEOS such that it helps the budding artists project their artwork beyond the humdrum life and societal mediocrity.

Like every other Action Painter, Prof. THEOS believed this genre of arts gives the artist complete freedom for creativity to thrive thereby making the act of painting more important than the work itself. The canvas becomes a tool to feast on rather than for the display of tangible images.

The action has faded out of THEOS' hands as he bows to the coldness of death but the power of impression and the action in his paintings will dwell with all those who come in contact with his personality and works. THEOS will be forever remembered by all of us for his well-executed artistic works and the pivotal role he played in the establishment of ATAFOM University.

His legacy and tribute would be the young, budding artists benefiting from the Faculty of Arts at the ATAFOM University which he helped conceive and nurture. Through them THEOS lives on.



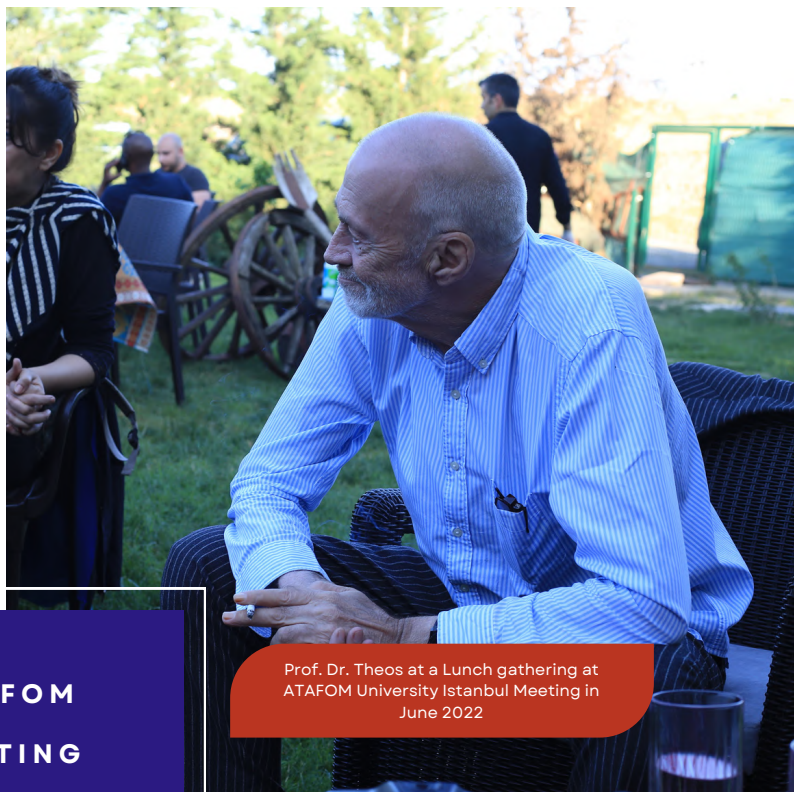
