



ATAFOM UNIVERSITY UP CLOSE WITH Exclusive Interview with Prof. Dr. Nevers Sekwila Mumba

In this exclusive conversation, Prof. Dr. Nevers Sekwila Mumba former Vice President of Zambia, diplomat, faith leader, and now Dean at ATAFOM University International reflects on his journey, leadership philosophy, and the ideas behind his new book, In Pursuit of Freedom. The discussion sheds light on freedom, ethics, and education as cornerstones of responsible leadership.

ATAFOM Newsletter: Prof. Mumba, congratulations on your new book. What inspired you to write In Pursuit of Freedom? What was the moment or experience that compelled you to put your philosophy of freedom into writing?

Prof. Dr. Nevers Sekwila Mumba: I have come to appreciate that freedom is not an event but an ongoing fight to improve one's life or nation. As significant as political freedom has been to Africa, our independence has not yet delivered the freedom we yearn for. Freedom to shape our own destiny. Freedom to own and exploit our own natural resources. Freedom to be original and not carbon copies of any other people group. This is my motivation behind my new book.

ATAFOM Newsletter: Why did you choose August 25, 2025, for the book's release? Was there a symbolic or personal significance behind that date?

Prof. Dr. Nevers Sekwila Mumba: There was no sentimental reason for choosing the date.



ATAFOM Newsletter: How long did it take to bring the book from concept to completion, and what challenges did you face along the way? What moments tested your resolve during the writing process?

Prof. Dr. Nevers Sekwila Mumba: It took me 15 years to write this book. The book was meant to introduce me and my controversial journey in politics ahead of the 2016 Presidential election. The book was meant to show that, "the equitable delivery of goods and services to any people depends on the morality and integrity of its leaders." My goal was to insist that men and women of faith must participate in politics in order to instill godly values into politics.

The length of time it took me to write created a challenge of always wanting to include new developments which in a way broadened the scope of the book instead of it being razor focused on Faith and Politics.

ATAFOM Newsletter: What is the core message you hope readers — particularly young Africans — will take from In Pursuit of Freedom? How do you want it to shape their view of leadership and personal responsibility?

Prof. Dr. Nevers Sekwila Mumba: The belief that "politics is a game.." has been the source of the huge problems Africa has faced the last 60 years. Politics devoid of values. Politics of violence and power play. In my book, I insist that until and unless we encourage people of faith and godly values in politics Africa will continue to be abused by godless and heartless dictators that have led our nations into poverty. Politics is not a game. It is the God structured vehicle meant to protect citizens from each other by insisting on the rule of law and the promotion of justice for all.

ATAFOM Newsletter: You've served as Vice President of Zambia, a diplomat, and now a university dean. How do these distinct roles intersect in shaping your broader vision of leadership?

Prof. Dr. Nevers Sekwila Mumba: I feel greatly honored to have served in politics as Vice President of my country. As ambassador and diplomat in Canada. I am also glad to serve in the academia as Dean for Political Science at ATAFOM university. This combination of key sectors of society has helped me to be a more seasoned and balanced leader. The combination of all this experience helps me to understand the challenges of Africa and an ability to offer solutions to my community.

ATAFOM Newsletter: Your academic background spans public policy and practical theology. What drew you to these disciplines, and how do they inform your worldview today?

Prof. Dr. Nevers Sekwila Mumba: I felt a call to serve God at the age of 17. I enrolled in Bible college at age 22 in Dallas, Texas and became a minister of the Gospel. My vision has always been to make Zambia a Christian nation. In 1990, it was constitutionally declared a Christian nation. It is this influence of Christianity on my nation that led me to get involved in politics to ensure that Christian values were instilled in the nation's polity. I further studied and obtained my masters in public policy at Regent University in Virginia Beach, VA.



ATAFOM Newsletter: As Dean of the Faculty of Political Science at ATAFOM University, what motivated you to take on this academic role? What is your long-term vision for the faculty and its place in global education?

Prof. Dr. Nevers Sekwila Mumba: I decided to take this academic role as a way of expending my rich experience in public policy and diplomatic service. I was further motivated in order to teach that politics without moral values is a danger to society. Greed and Corruption in politics is as a result of the absence of godly values.

My long term vision is to grow the faculty of Political Science so that it becomes the breeding place of presidents.

ATAFOM Newsletter: How do you plan to translate your ideas on freedom and governance into the academic life of ATAFOM University? What does "freedom in practice" look like in a university setting?

Prof. Dr. Nevers Sekwila Mumba: Freedom is necessary for students to be able to innovate. To be creative in introducing new concepts of governance. The message of freedom will unleash a new vibrant and innovative generation of young people. Only a free people are capable of developing a nation.

ATAFOM Newsletter: ATAFOM University champions global education with African relevance. How does that vision connect to your belief in "Education for Integration"?

Prof. Dr. Nevers Sekwila Mumba: I am convinced that ATAFOM'S approach to education is compatible with my message of freedom. Africa must adopt her own relevant curriculum in order to bring development in Africa. Imported educational systems have not served Africa well. In my book, I have insisted that until we introduce home grown educational systems, freedom shall continue to be illusive.

ATAFOM Newsletter: In what ways do you expect your book to influence curriculum development, research focus, or student mentorship at ATAFOM? Can In Pursuit of Freedom become a teaching tool for the next generation of political thinkers?

Prof. Dr. Nevers Sekwila Mumba: My book IN PURSUIT FOR FREEDOM was written specifically to be used as a research tool. Its focus is to show why so many African countries are failing. To create a new path for African governments to become authentic.

ATAFOM Newsletter: Since its release, what kind of feedback have you received from readers and the international community? Have any reactions surprised or deeply resonated with you?

Prof. Dr. Nevers Sekwila Mumba: The feedback in Zambia has been beyond my expectation. The book has inspired both the old and the young who believe that Africa must take its destiny in its own hands. The book has also highlighted that the current underdevelopment and poverty of most Africa is tied to a lack of morality and integrity in leadership.



ATAFOM Newsletter: What legacy do you hope In Pursuit of Freedom will leave — both intellectually and practically — in shaping political thought and leadership?

Prof. Dr. Nevers Sekwila Mumba: The book will reshape the political space in Zambia and Africa as a whole. It is a typical African story of an unassuming young man who went against all odds. From a village boy without shoes to the position of Vice President. The book speaks to the truth that. "I can do all things through Christ who gives me strength."

ATAFOM Newsletter: Having spent decades in both ministry and politics, how do you see the relationship between faith, ethics, and governance today? Can moral conviction and political pragmatism truly coexist?

Prof. Dr. Nevers Sekwila Mumba: Moral Conviction and political pragmatism must coexist. A stable society needs an equal measure of all these values. Faith, ethics and governance must work together.

ATAFOM Newsletter: What do you view as the major ethical challenges facing today's leaders, and how can they guard against them? Is the moral compass still relevant in modern politics?

Prof. Dr. Nevers Sekwila Mumba: Many african leaders join politics to satisfy greed and as a means to enrich themselves. This belief has drastically cut down on chances for servant leadership. Until we get men and women of faith in leadership, there will be no moral compass amongst political leaders.

ATAFOM Newsletter: What daily habit or personal discipline has helped you stay grounded and effective in leadership over the years?

Prof. Dr. Nevers Sekwila Mumba: My faith in God has been the solid foundation upon which I base all my political decisions and actions. I also study biographies of great political leaders of the past, like Zambia's first president Kenneth Kaunda. Nelson Mandela of South Africa and many others.

ATAFOM Newsletter: You've earned recognition on the global stage. What do Africa's emerging leaders need to do differently to navigate and lead effectively in today's complex global landscape?

Prof. Dr. Nevers Sekwila Mumba: African younger generation of leaders must faith have faith in themselves. They must never be carbon copies of neither the West or the East. They must have the freedom to evolve their own ideas. Only a free leader can lead effectively.

ATAFOM Newsletter: Freedom is both a personal pursuit and a societal ideal. How do you define freedom — and what do you see as the greatest threats to it today?

Prof. Dr. Nevers Sekwila Mumba: Freedom is always and exclusively freedom for the one who thinks differently. Poverty is the greatest threat to freedom. A poor man or a beggar cannot participate in an intelligent debate because he fears losing the hand outs.



ATAFOM Newsletter: How has In Pursuit of Freedom been received internationally since its publication? Have you seen differences in how readers from various regions interpret its message?

Prof. Dr. Nevers Sekwila Mumba: Although I am the author, I have learnt so much from the feedback I have received from all over the world. It is clear that every society has a different interpretation of what true freedom means.



Areas of application of AI in university education

- 3: Self-optimizing systems that create personalized offers based on big data and continuous learning.

b) Support for teachers

- •Creation of teaching materials: Al-powered tools support the creation of presentations, learning materials and interactive elements. As Al quality progresses, these systems can independently adapt and expand teaching content.
- •Communication and interaction: Availability of a chatbot that answers questions in real time, supports literature and source research, and offers exercises to consolidate the learning material.
- •Performance diagnostics: AI-based analysis tools provide individual feedback and evaluations of the students' level of knowledge, which enables differentiation according to the individually achieved learning level.

c) Promotion of independent research and access to literature

- •Support in accessing further sources, research databases and literature.
- •Recommendation systems that are tailored to individual interests and learning progress.

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
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
